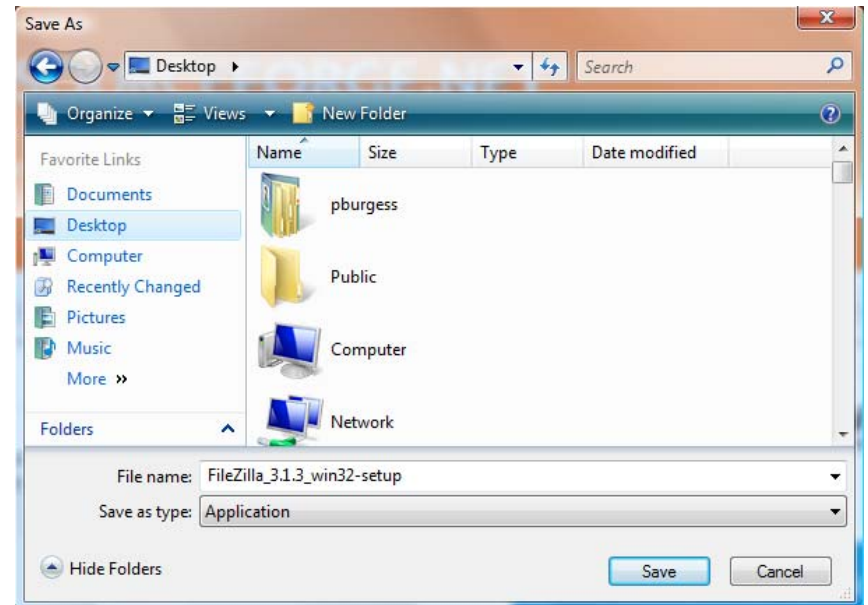
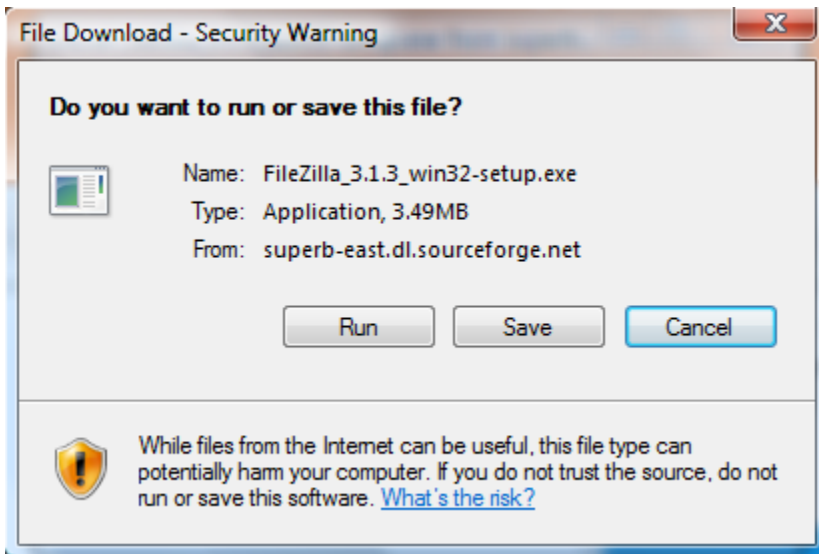

Save the downloaded file to a location that is easy to remember – like the desktop.



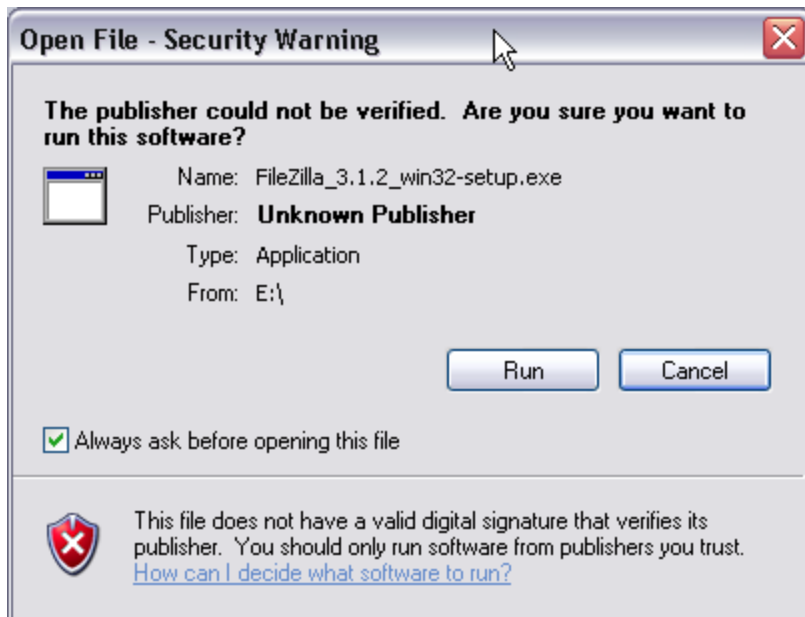

the install process.

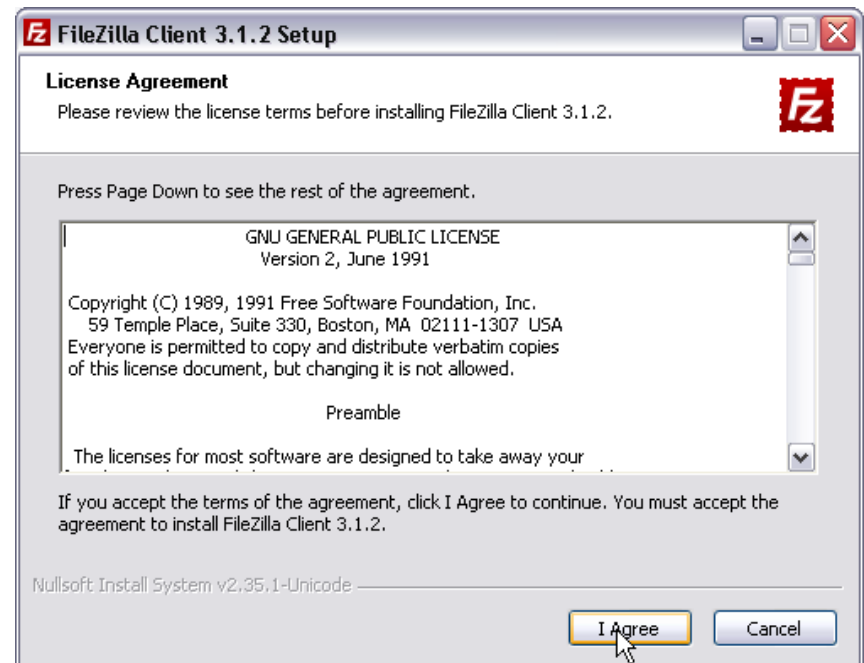


Part 2: Install Software

If you get this warning click run



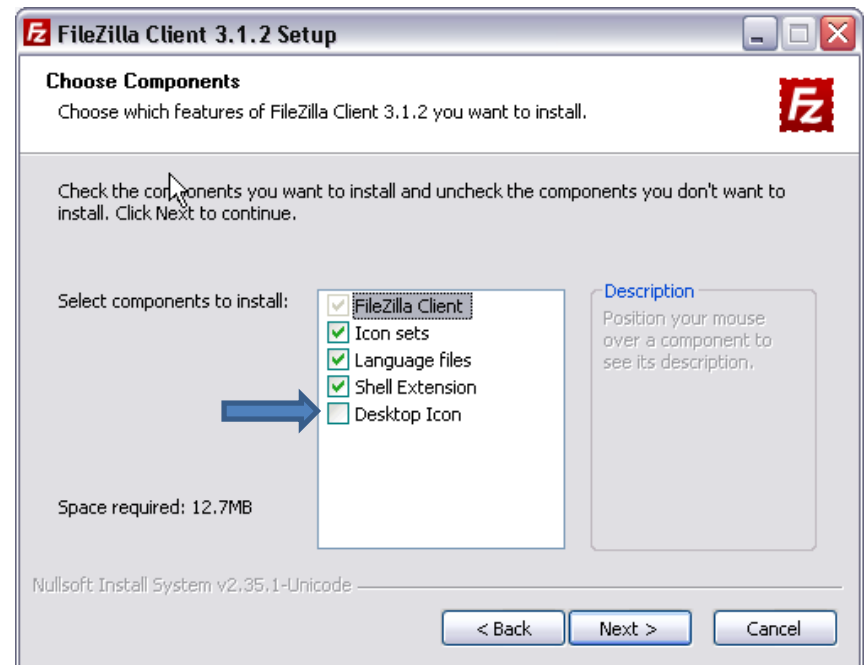
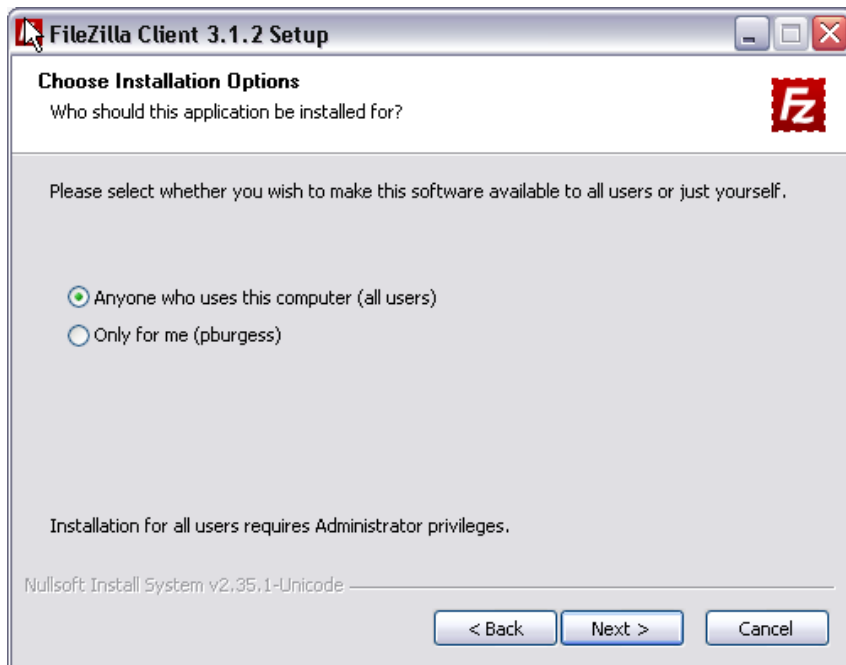
Read license and Click "I Agree"

For simplicity select the first option.

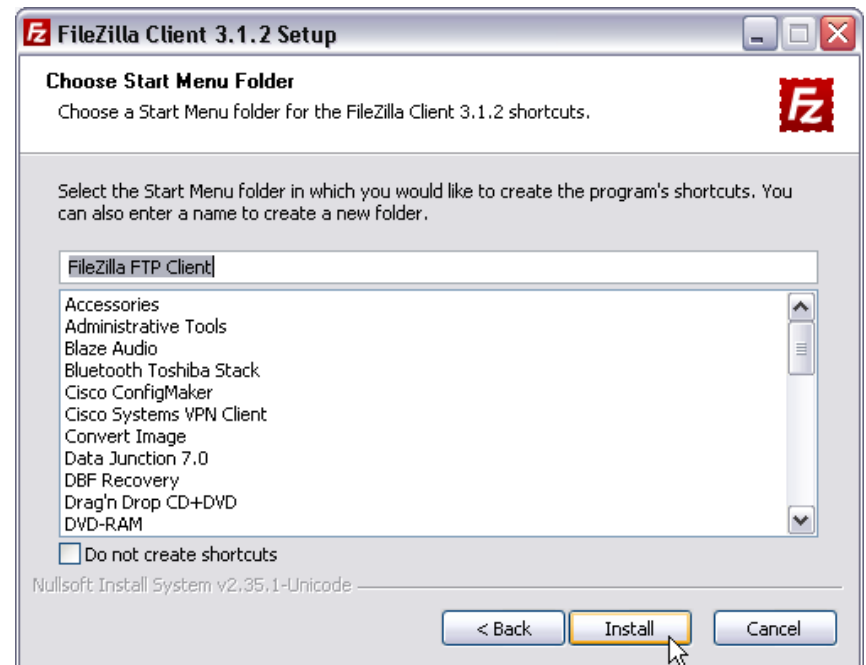
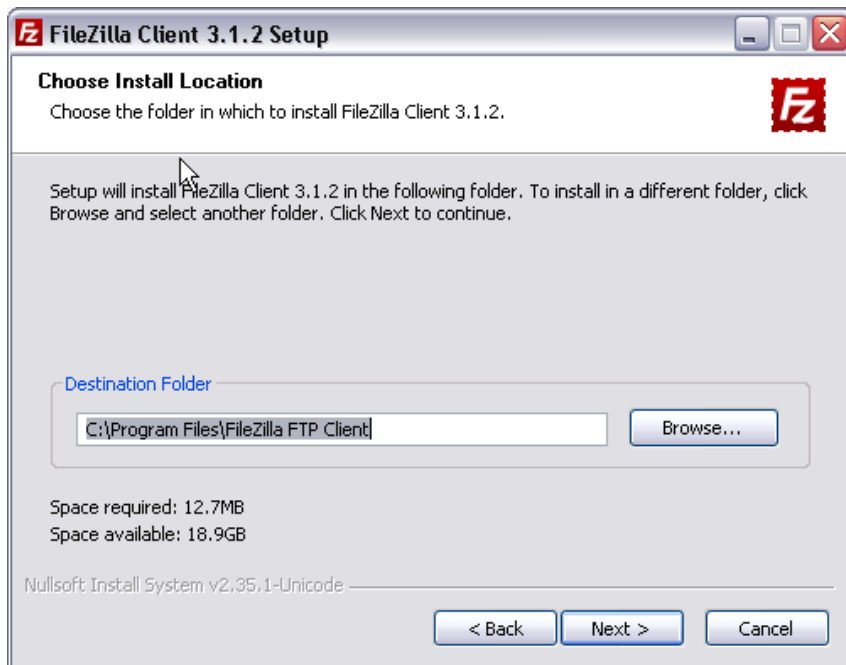
If you would like a desktop icon check the Desktop Icon box



Install Software - continued

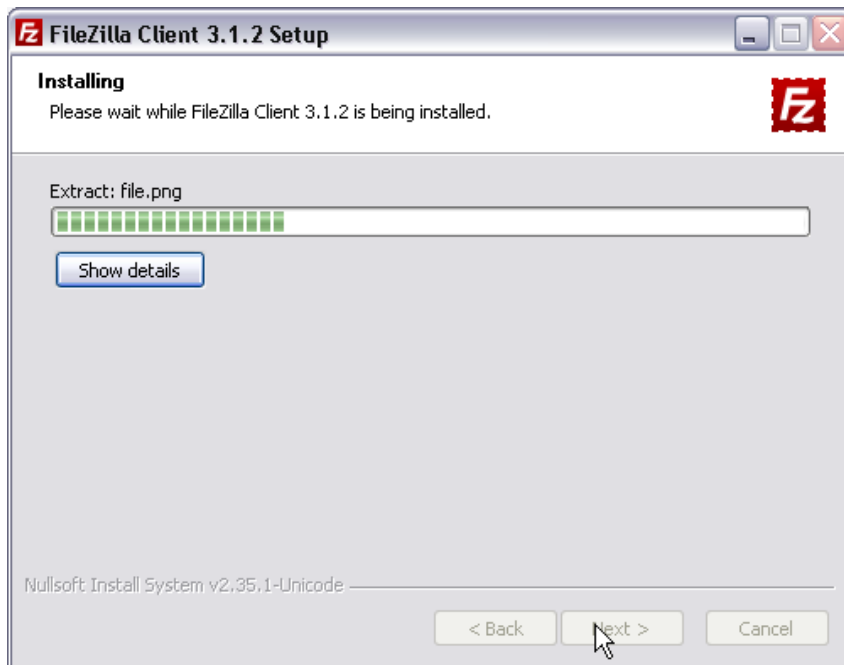
Keep the default location, just click the next button.

Keep the default folder name, just click next button.

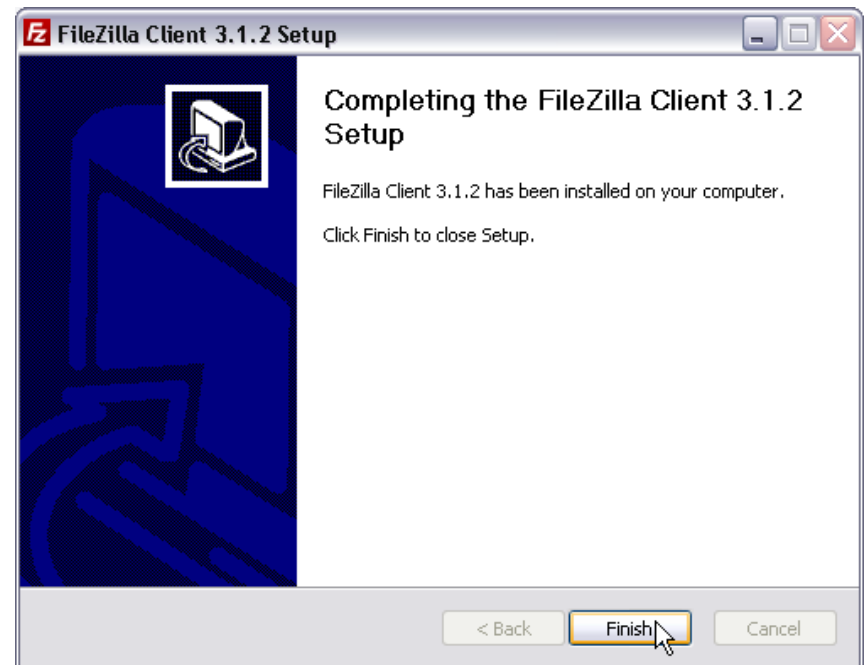


Install Software - continued

Wait for the copy process to complete.

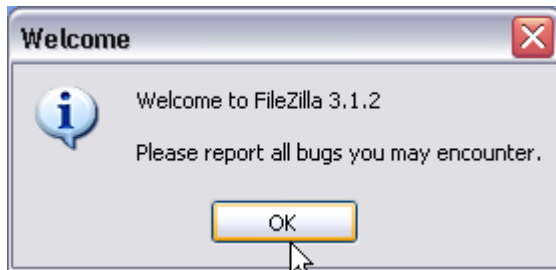


Click the finish button to complete the installation.



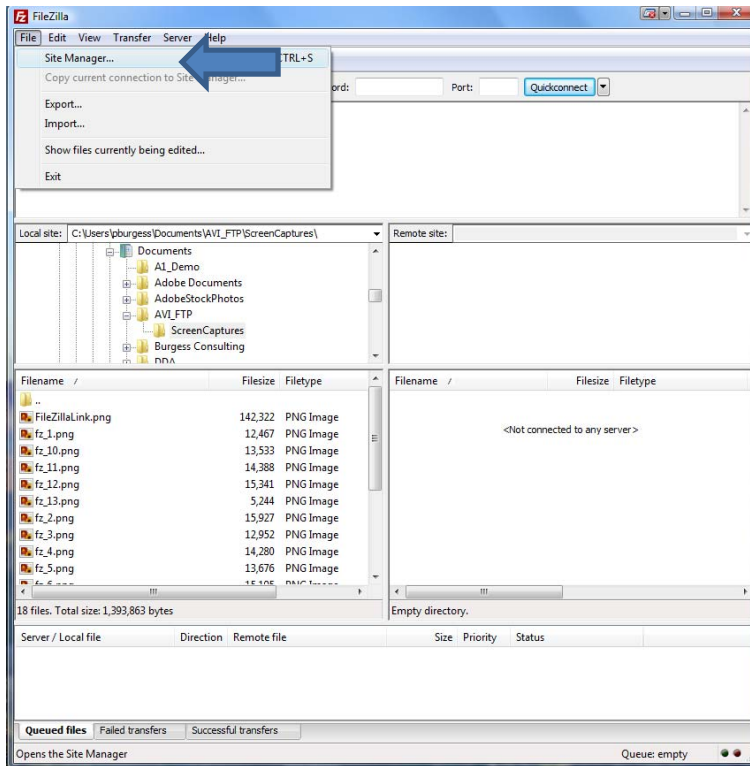
Install Software - continued

Click the OK button on the welcome window.

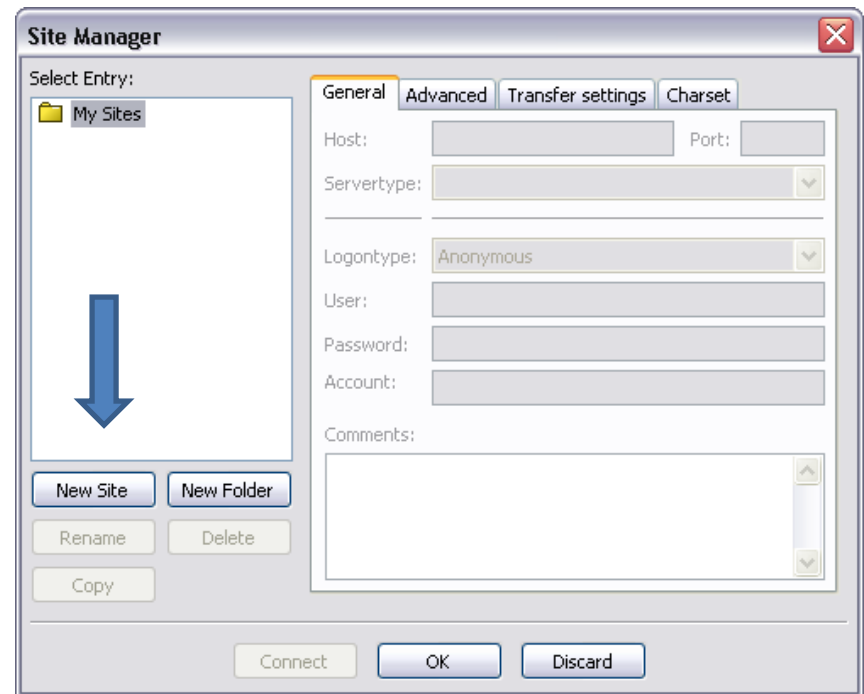


Part 3: Configure MoNEP Account

Start the FileZilla FTP client and Select “Site Manager” from the File menu

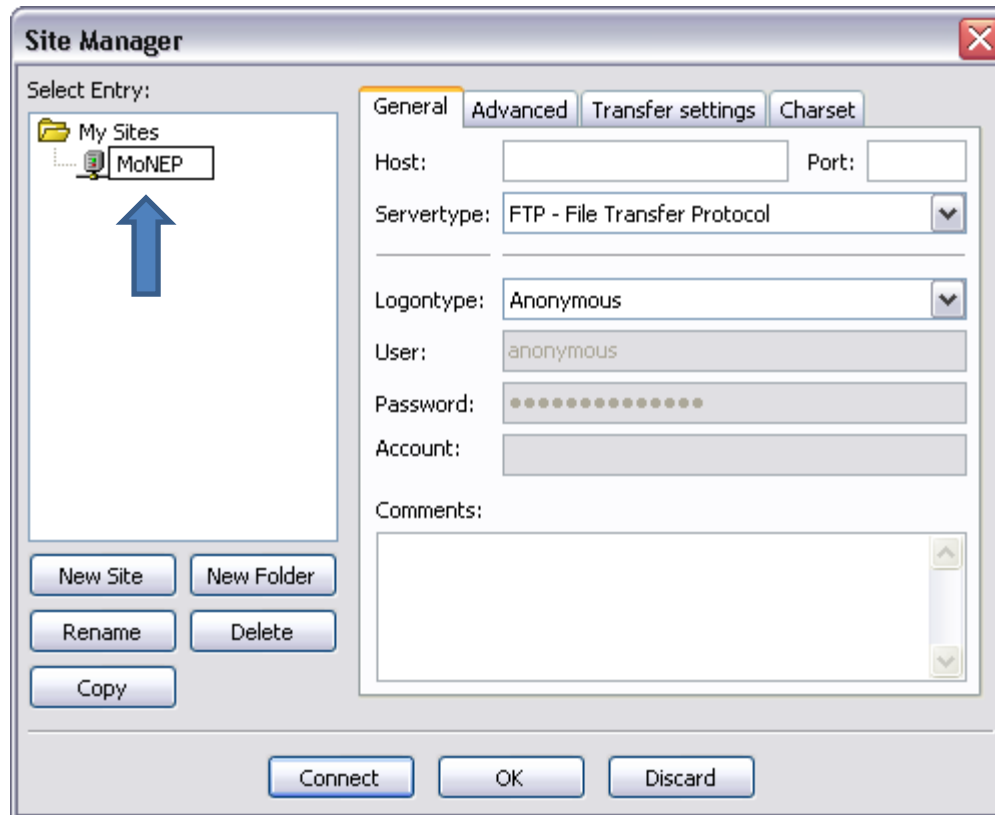


Click “New Site” to create an entry

- Enter MoNEP as an entry name

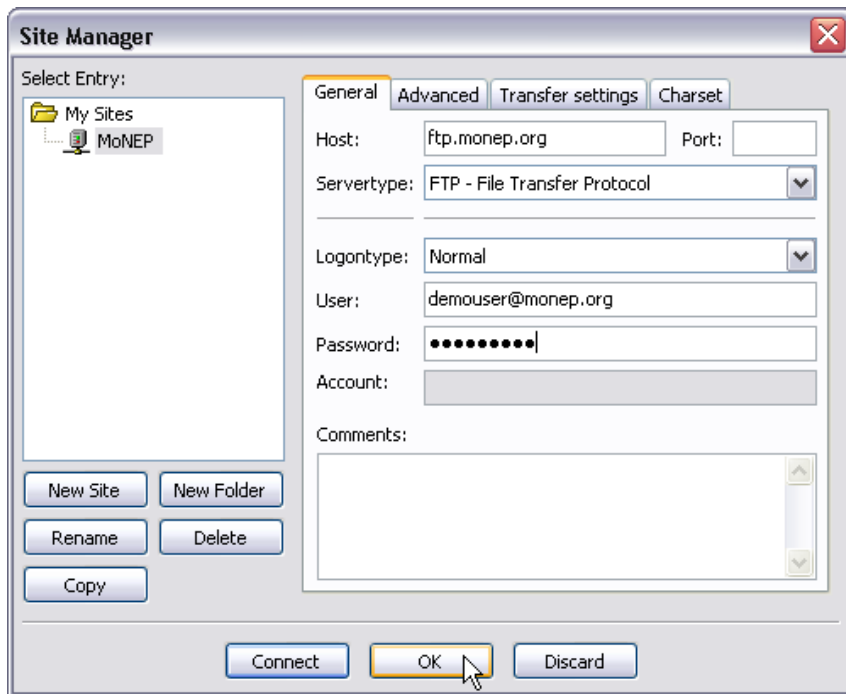


Configure MoNEP Account - Continued

Enter the required account information on the General Tab

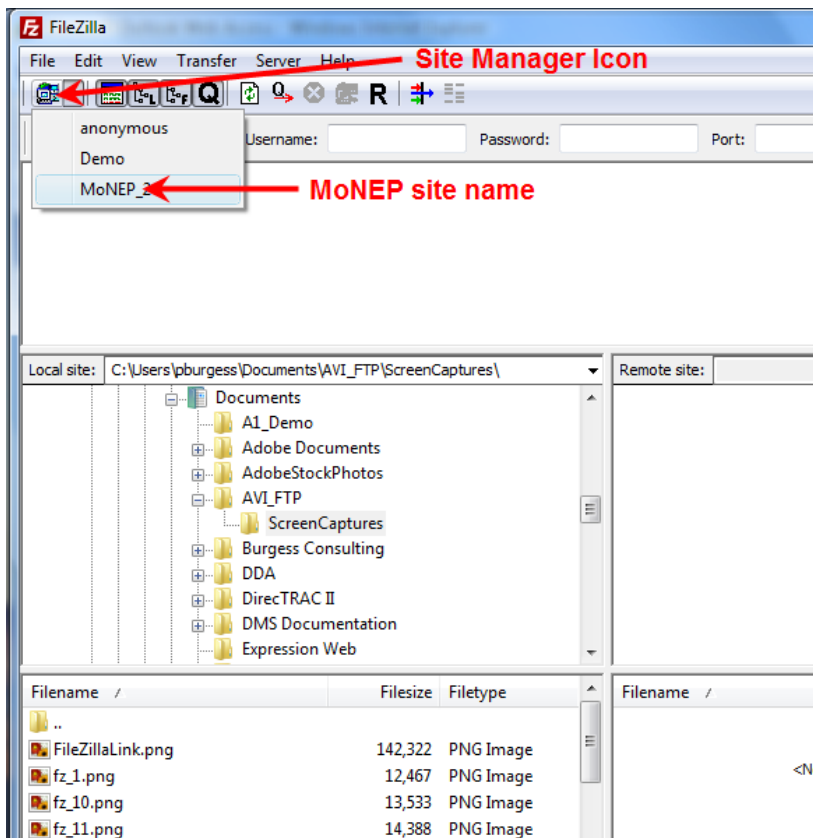
Enter or select the values on the “General” tab as shown below

- Host = <ftp.monep.org>
- ServerType = **FTP – File Transfer Protocol**
- Logontype = **Normal**
- User (enter as e-mailed)
- Password (enter as e-mailed)



Part 4: Logon to MoNEP site

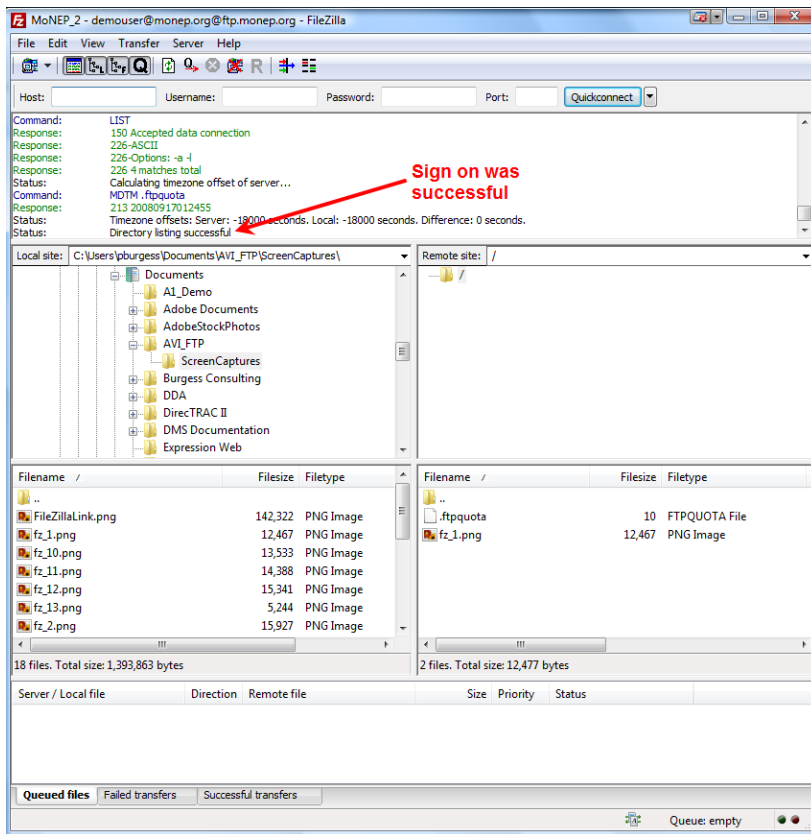
Log into the ftp site



- Click the “Site Manager” Icon to open the list of FTP sites. (MoNEP should be the only site in the list).
- Click “MoNEP” in the drop down menu to log onto the MoNEP FTP site.

Logon to MoNEP site - Continued

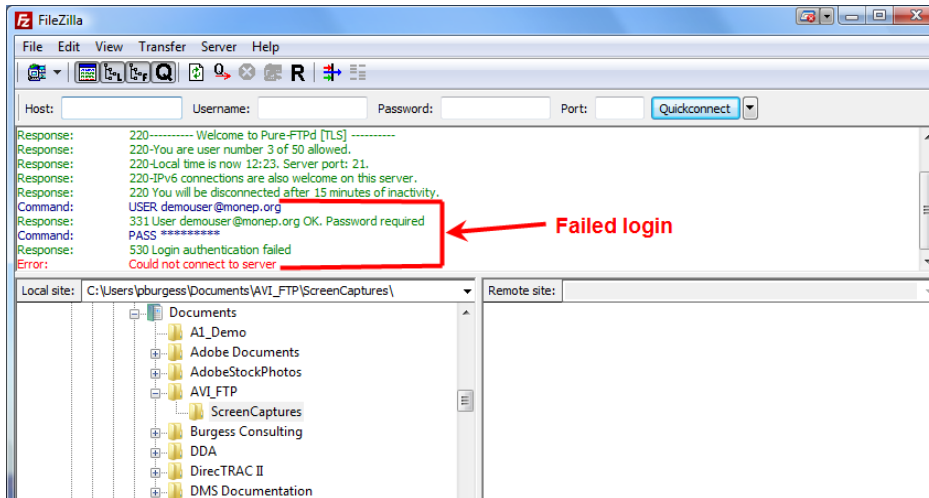
Successful Logon Attempt
